Who are we for?

The team is for students who are struggling, need extra attention to help them graduate, or who are looking for new challenges in high school.

- Benefit from individualized attention.
- Choose from more options for learning such as coop education, credit recovery, dual credits, and e-learning.
- Seek help in solving problems they previously may have faced alone.

The Student Success Team is available to every student who needs more attention or motivation. Additional resources are also available for parents, students, teachers and employers.

How does this affect *Edsby* Expectations?

- With the addition of *Edsby* at Smithville Christian Student Services will no longer send home monthly anecdotal known as the Student Academic Monitor (SAM Report).
- All staff are encouraged to contact students and parents who become at risk in their classes. It is our hope that parents and students take on the responsibility as they become more familiar and comfortable with *Edsby*.
- The Student Success team will monitor students via *Edsby*, but we ask that teachers, parents, guardians or students inform a member of the Student Success Team if they are aware of a student who needs additional support.

When do we meet?

The Student Success Team will meet monthly, the first week of each month, and will call additional meetings if needed. On occasion, we will also call special meetings with classroom teachers when a specific student needs customized support.

(Note: The Student Success Team replaces the Special Needs Committee. *Mandate approved January 8, 2014*)
